Why this Conference

- **1.** Indian Constitution was amended in 1992 through the 73rd & 74th amendments in order to provide the Local Self-Governments (LSGs) their rightful place in the process of Nation Building. It provides, amongst others for (i) Constitutional status to the LSGs and (ii) an Independent State Election Commission in each state for timely conduct of elections in a free, fair & transparent manner.
- **2.** State Election Commission, Maharashtra (SECM), which was established in 1994, returns more than 250,000 local representatives every 5 years, in approximately 28,000 LSGs.
- **3.** Though lot of efforts have been made in the past 25 years, some people still do not adequately recognize the role of LSGs in Nation Building and also do not treat State Election Commissions as Independent authorities at par with the Election Commission of India. Therefore, there is an urgent need to bring the LSGs & their elections to the center stage so that real democracy flourishes at grassroots level.
- **4.** In order to overcome the above, SECM is hosting an International Conference of Election Commissioners to share & disseminate the good practices, with an aim:
 - i. To unpack & identify challenges around:
 - Ownership of Democracy Inclusiveness Menace of Social Media / Fake News etc., Misuse of Money Power etc. Role of Various Stakeholders
 - ii. To have common platform for sharing the experiences & good practices, and
 - iii. To develop a system for conducting research & new experiments.
- **5.** This is probably the first attempt of its kind towards creating a 'Healthier Democracy through Better Elections' at local self-government level.
