CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. SEC./1094/225/1994.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 243-ZA of the Constitution of India, read with sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of section 14 of the Bombay Provincial Municipal Corporations Act, 1949 (Bom. LIX of 1949), (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act") and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I, D. N. Chaudhari, State Election Commissioner, Maharashtra, hereby —

(a) to the Divisional Commissioner, the power of appointing a Designated Officer, from amongst officers of the State Government under sub-section (1) of section 7AA of the said Act ; and

(b) appoint the Collector, or an officer appointed by the Collector, to be the Appellate Officer for the purposes of sub-section (3) of section 7A of the said Act.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. SEC./1094/191/94.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 243-ZA of the Constitution of India, read with sections 14 of the Bombay Provincial Municipal Corporations Act, 1949 (Bom. LIX of 1949), I., D.N. Chaudhari, State Election Commissioner, Maharashtra State, hereby,—

(a) authorise the Municipal Commissioners for the purposes of rules 8A, 8C, 9(2)(f), 9A, 9C, 21, 54 and 55 of the Election Rules in Chapter I in the Schedule to the Bombay Provincial Municipal Corporations Act, 1949, as amended by the Municipal Corporation of the City of Aurangabad by Notification No. 86/AMC/ELN/CR-46, dated the 8th January 1987 and all other rules, if any, in relation to the election to the Municipal Corporation, and ;

(b) direct that the Municipal Commissioner shall exercise these powers subject to my superintendence, direction and control and without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 14 of the Bombay Provincial Municipal Corporations Act, 1949.
