CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. SEC-1094/164/1994.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 243-ZA of the Constitution of India read with sub-sections (1), (2) and (4) of section 10A of the Maharashtra Municipal Councils, Jagar panchayats and Industrial townships Act, 1965 (Mah. XL of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act") and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I, D. N. Chaudhari, State Election Commissioner, Maharashtra, hereby—

- (a) delegate the powers under sections, sub-sections and clauses of the said Act and under rules, sub-rules and clauses of the Maharashtra Municipal Councils and Nagar panchayats election rules, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as "the Election Rules") for the purpose and to the extent specified in column (2) of the schedule hereto, to the officers of the State Government and the Municipal Councils as shown against each of them in column (3) of the said Schedule and
- (b) direct that these officers of the State Government and of the Municipal Councils shall exercise these powers subject to my superintendence, direction and control and without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 10-A of the said Act.
